

BRAZIL WINDPOWER 2026 - CALL FOR TECHNICAL PAPERS

The Brazilian Wind Energy Association (ABEEólica) announces below the rules for the submission of technical papers, which will be evaluated for publication and/or presentation as part of the activities of Brazil Windpower 2026.

CATEGORIES

Submitted papers must fit into one of the categories specified below, along with their subtopics:

1. Wind Resource Analysis

- Wind Resource Assessment, Analysis, and Forecasting
- Measurement of Wind Physical Guarantee and Generation Performance
- Complementarity (between sources and/or regions)

2. O&M

- Studies and case studies on the operation of wind farms
- Studies and case studies on the maintenance of wind farms
- Innovations in the O&M field
- Applications of artificial intelligence, IoT, and energy performance
- Turbine optimization, wind farm control, and AEP increase
- Decommissioning, Repowering, and turbine life extension
- Digitalization: smart turbines, smart wind farms, and value creation

3. Offshore Wind*

- Offshore wind: technology, development, and operation
- Offshore wind combined with other technologies, such as hydrogen solutions and Power-to-X
- Offshore wind and floating solutions
- Offshore wind and challenges for system connection and integration
- Offshore wind and environmental licensing
- Offshore wind regulation and commercialization

4. Regulation and Commercialization

- Studies, proposals, and case studies on wind energy regulation
- Studies, proposals, and case studies on wind energy commercialization in the regulated and/or free market

5. New Technologies*

- Hybrid Projects
- Research, Development, and Innovation
- Storage and ancillary services
- Green hydrogen – Production, Storage, Transportation, and Energy Use
- Data centers

*Excluding new technologies for O&M, which fall under the O&M category, and offshore technologies, which fall under the new and exclusive offshore category.

6. Miscellaneous

FORMAT FOR PAPER PRESENTATION

All papers must include Title, Abstract, Content, and References, following the event's formatting model. The content should clearly present the paper's objective, focus, results, and conclusions.

For formatting, use A4 paper size and follow ABNT rules for formatting, spacing, font, and presentation of graphs and tables. Authors from other countries should consider the academic formatting rules commonly used in their respective countries.

Papers may be submitted in Portuguese, Spanish, or English. For papers in Portuguese or Spanish, an Abstract in English must be included.

Papers may have a maximum of 14 pages, including references.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

2.1 – Papers must be submitted electronically through the following website: www.brazilwindpower.com.br, which will be available starting **April 15, 2026**, as per the schedule presented below in item 4. When submitting the paper, it is mandatory to send two files: one in Word format and another in PDF format.

Evaluation and Selection Criteria

- Papers will be evaluated by specialists using a blind peer review process. This method ensures that reviewers do not have access to the authors' or presenters' information, promoting an objective and unbiased analysis. Additionally, the specialists responsible for the evaluation have no direct relationship with the papers or their respective authors, ensuring the integrity and impartiality of the evaluation process. If there is a score difference of 3 points or more between reviewers, a third evaluation will be conducted by another reviewer to determine the final score of the paper.
- Papers will be scored from 0 to 10 based on the following criteria:
 - Relevance of the topic and its application to the Brazilian Wind Sector
 - Review of relevant and current literature
 - Structure of the paper's content
 - Degree of innovation of the topic in the sector
 - Identification of the paper's issue and proposed solutions
 - Scientific contribution of the results

- Quality of the results obtained
- Formulation of conclusions
- Quality of the paper's text
- Overall evaluation of the paper
- The final score of the paper will be calculated based on the average of the scores for the above criteria.
- The top 10 papers in each category will be selected for publication. The top 3 papers in each category will be invited for oral presentation as part of the BWP 2026 activities.
- Papers selected for publication and/or presentation may be subject to corrections pointed out by the reviewers. In such cases, the author will have a deadline to make the necessary corrections. Failure to do so within the specified timeframe will result in disqualification.

SCHEDULE

- **April 8, 2026:** Announcement of the rules for paper submission
- **April 15, 2026:** Papers can be submitted through the website indicated in item 2.1
- **July 1, 2026:** Deadline for paper submission
- **July 20, 2026:** Authors of papers classified for presentation and/or publication, and those requiring corrections, will be notified. Corrections must be submitted by **July 31, 2026**. Failure to meet this deadline will result in disqualification.
- **August 18, 2026:** Authors of selected papers will be notified via email regarding their selection for presentation and/or publication.
- **August 30, 2026:** Deadline for authors of selected papers to submit their PowerPoint presentations for the event.
- **October 9, 2026:** The event organizers will publish the schedule of paper presentations on the website.
- **October 27-29, 2026:** Paper presentations.

PRESENTATION

Authors of selected papers for presentation must use the PowerPoint template provided by the event organizers.

Presenters must submit their presentations electronically by **August 30, 2026**.

- The presentations will take place in person from **October 27 to 29, 2026**, as part of the Brazil Windpower program. The presentation schedule will be published on the event website on **October 9, 2026**, indicating the time allocated for each author. The event offers free entry for one of the authors of the selected paper. The event organizers will not cover transportation or meals for the author during the event.
- Presentation sessions will be coordinated by an invited expert, ensuring adherence to the schedule.
- Each presentation may only be conducted by a single Author/Presenter.
- The Author/Presenter must strictly adhere to the scheduled time. Failure to appear at the scheduled time will result in the loss of the right to present.
- Certificates will be issued with the presentation title, the presenter's name, and the co-authors' names as listed in the registration form. Only one certificate will be issued per paper, and it will be delivered at the end of each session.

PUBLICATION OF PAPERS

Papers selected for presentation will be compiled into an online publication, which will be made available on the event website and the ABEEólica website.

EVENT ACCESS

Each paper selected for presentation entitles one author to full free access to Brazil Windpower 2026, including all lectures. For papers with multiple authors, the authors must decide who will use the free entry.
